The gardens at Gravetye Manor are a very special place and can be considered amongst the most influential in English gardening history. The manor became the home of the creative, innovative and revolutionary gardener, William Robinson in 1884.

Robinson's ideas about naturalised plantings, allowing nature to flow into the garden, were ground breaking. Today Gravetye is a mature, charming and very beautiful garden. Areas of wild garden contrast seamlessly with more formal arrangements, and all the while surrounded by stunning countryside views.

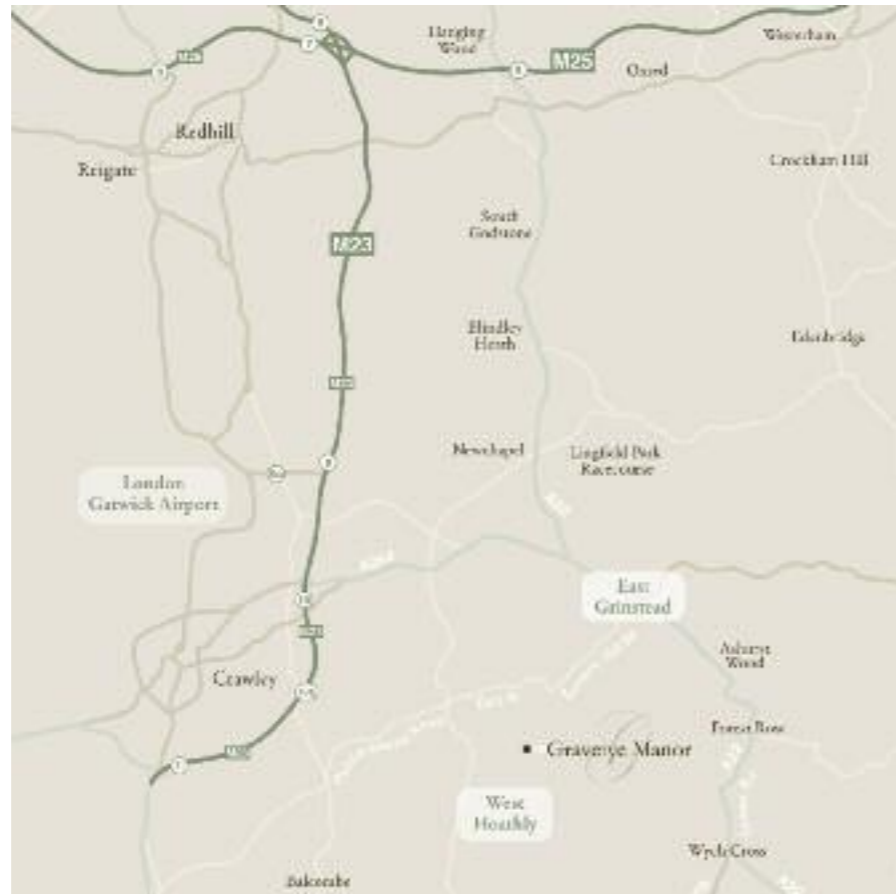
